Y2 Visit to Radlett Reform Synagogue & St Lawrence's Church – Tuesday 18th March

During the Spring Term I have planned to visit **Radlett Reform Synagogue and St Lawrence's** to support our Religious Education topic, Judaism and Christianity. We will leave school by coach at 9.15am and visit the Synagogue from 10am until 12pm. On our way back from the Synagogue we will be stopping off to eat lunch and visit St Lawrence's Church, Cholesbury. We will be back at school by 3pm and therefore collection will be at the usual time of 3.15pm.

All children will be provided with a packed lunch from Aspire. They will choose their sandwich options in school and children with allergies will also catered for. Lunch will be eaten at St Lawrence's Church.

During the visit to the Synagogue, a volunteer will give the class a tour, share lots of valuable information about Judaism as well as showing artefacts that will help the children to understand more about the religion. During the visit there will also be a 'squash and challah' break whereby the children will be able to taste the celebration bread. Ingredients in Challah are egg, flour, water, salt, yeast and egg. I will get in contact with parents with children who have allergies to identify if we need to provide alternative bread on the day.

We will aim to mirror the visit at St Lawrence's church so that the children can identify similarities and differences between the places of worship.

We would be grateful to have some parent volunteers to come along with us, so please let us know on the Google Form if you are available to help from 9am to 3pm on Tuesday 18th March.

The cost of the trip is £16.25 per child, which covers the cost of the coach and includes a £1 donation to the synagogue. Families who are eligible for Pupil Premium will be contacted separately regarding payment.
