Funding for PE and Sport provision

At Hawridge & Cholesbury C of E School we are pleased to announce that the Government have given our school £8,720 per annum as a grant for PE and Sport provision. The primary aim is to raise the profile of and improve the provision of PE and sport in school and to ensure healthy and active lifestyles. The Government are supporting and encouraging schools to provide professional development opportunities for their staff, provide cover/release time for teachers for professional development in PE/Sport, to hire specialist PE teachers/qualified sports coaches to work alongside teachers teaching PE, provide places for pupils on after school sport clubs, to run sporting competitions or increase participation in school games and to buy in quality assured professional development for schools.

In particular at Hawridge & Cholesbury C of E School we spend the Sports Grant according to three specific priorities

- To provide a wide range of sporting opportunities from specialists, both as part of the curriculum and through extracurricular clubs.
- As a village school, we prioritise opportunities for our pupils to compete and participate in sports with other schools.
- Thirdly, we prioritise using this grant to improve the health and wellbeing of all our pupils both socially and through healthy eating.
