Written statement of behaviour principles

- > Every pupil understands they have the right to feel safe, valued and respected, and to be able to learn, free from the disruption of others
- > All pupils, staff and visitors are free from any form of discrimination
- > Staff and volunteers set an excellent example and adhere to our school values at all times
- > The school Behaviour Policy is understood by pupils and staff
- > Rewards and sanctions are used consistently by staff, in line with the Behaviour Policy.
- > De-escalation strategies will be used to prevent the need for physical management of a child wherever possible
- > Where physical management is needed it will only be carried out by fully trained staff and it will be recorded and reported to parents
- > Suspensions and Exclusions are only used as a last resort.
- > Pupils are helped to take responsibility for their actions and restorative practices are used to support this
- > Families are involved in behaviour incidents to foster good relationships between the school and pupils' home life
- > Violence or threatening behaviour will not be tolerated in any circumstances.
